### Can you help with an easy fundraising opportunity for the school

#### Research on the Coastal Marine Ecosystem affecting you

You are invited to take part in a seminar, Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> August, aimed at finding out the values you place on the coastal marine environment. New Zealand is continually exposed to foreign pests and diseases that can potentially threaten our coast line.

Nimmo-Bell is carrying out research to measure the values you place on the coastal marine environment. This research will help Biosecurity New Zealand provide more informed advice to the government than is currently possible.

**The seminar will take the form of a group exercise, which will last about 90 minutes**, where information will be given out prior to a series of questions. These questions will relate to choices affecting the values of the coast line including potential changes to what you see and experience, sea food catches and the costs of eradicating a new pest threatening the coast.

**No particular qualifications or experience are necessary.** We are interested in your personal views. **The information you provide will be kept confidential**, will not be disclosed in any way that will identify you and you may withdraw at any time. No preparation is necessary just come along.

**Everyone completing the exercise will be provided with a \$20 petrol voucher as a thank you for participating.** Paremata School will benefit by a donation of \$50 for each person completing the questionnaire.
