### School Production Information

Dear Parents and Caregivers

The school production ***Are We There Yet?*** is fast approaching with shows on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday evenings 17-19<sup>th</sup> September starting promptly at 6.00pm. As you will know the staff, children and support parents have worked very hard putting the production together and we are really looking forward to performing for you.

I would like to share the following information to make the evenings enjoyable for all and your cooperation would be greatly appreciated.

#### Tickets

Production tickets are \$8.00 each and are on sale at the office now. Be in quick because they are selling fast. Payments can be made by eftpos, cash or directly into our bank account as long as you record your name, which night and how many tickets – ASB 12 3254 0048796 00. Students who are in the audience watching the show will also need to purchase a ticket.

#### Arrival at School

All of the children who are performing will need to be at school by 5.15pm **for all three nights**; Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup>, Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> and Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> September. They will get ready for the show in their dressing rooms, perform their part on stage then return to the classroom until the show is over. They can be collected from these rooms before the end of the production if their parent /caregiver **is not** attending the show. If parents and caregivers are watching the show the children can only be collected at the end of the production (time to be confirmed). If your child becomes unwell and cannot perform please can you contact your child's teacher as soon as possible.

#### Production start time

The show will start promptly at 6.00pm at which time the doors to the hall will be closed as they make a lot of noise when they are opened. Therefore, please ensure you are in your seats by 5.55pm (Doors will open at 5.40pm). Late arrivals will have to wait until the scene changes to come into the hall.

#### Mobile phones

All cellphones will need to be turned off for the duration of the production. No videoing or photography will be allowed using a phone or camera as this may annoy other patrons and put the children off, on stage. Photos will be available for free download after the production.

#### School starting times

School will be starting at 9am as usual during production week. However, if your child needs an extra hour to help get over the later nights we are allowing a 10am start on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday mornings.
