Did you know that?

New Zealand's native frogs are not swamp or pond-dwellers. Three of the species live in shady, moist, undisturbed forests, while the Hochstetter's frog lives a semi-aquatic life on stream edges. The three **introduced Australian** species of frog are the ones that generally live in or near ponds, have loud mating calls and pass through a tadpole stage. Our Native frogs are declining because they are sensitive to disease, pollution, chemical poisons and environmental changes, as they absorb many things

through their sensitive, semi-permeable skin.

Possible Solution: Be aware of the above and also avoid touching the frogs, because you may damage their sensitive
