ENVIRONEWS – RUMA KIWI

Problem

Did you know that the Kakapo is the rarest parrot in the world? It is critically endangered with less than 150 of them left in the world. The reason the Kakapo is so engendered is that when predators came to New Zealand they easily killed the Kakapo. It didn't help that Kakapo only breed when there is enough Rimu fruit on the Rimu trees which is every 2-4 years.



Solution

To help the Kakapo you would need to spread the awareness of how endangered they are. There is a group of Department of Conservation Rangers trying to save them in a small island by Stewart Island.
