ENVIRONEWS – THE MAUI DOLPHIN

Fact- The Maui dolphin is critically endangered and both the Department of Conservation and the International agencies think this too. There are only 55 Maui Dolphins left in the world, and they are facing immediate danger of extinction. Maui Dolphins are located on the west side of the North Island.

Solution- The Department of Conservation have taken big steps forward to try and help the Maui dolphins. There are bans on set netting and trawling on the west side of North Island. The Department of Conservation have been working hard to protect them and they hope that these special Dolphins will stay alive.
