- Resilience (Manahau) Can you keep trying if something goes wrong?





THE CUTE LITTLE NEW ZEALAND GECKO

- Green geckos are guite loud for their size and produce a sound more like a 'bark' Woof Woof!!
- Geckos have 'sticky' feet: their toes are covered with microscopic hairs that allow them to climb walls and even walk upside down across the ceiling. Super Gecko!!
- Unlike skinks, geckos cannot blink and must lick their eyes to keep them moist. Can you do that??
- Geckos are able to 'drop' their tails. This is a predator defense mechanism—the tail continues to thrash around while the gecko makes its escape; the tail then regrows over the next few years. Clever ah!!
- Predators include mice, rats, hedgehogs, weasels, stoats, ferrets, cats, possums and pigs. Sad!!
