ACTIVITY FEE - COMPULSORY FEE - \$120 FOR THE YEAR

The compulsory activity fee covers shows and trips that children attend each year. It also covers the mathletics, and other IT programmes, classroom consumables and the swimming/aquatics programmes run throughout the year.

We have set budgets for these for 2018, so that parents can pay the money in one lump sum, on a term by term basis, or as a regular direct credit.
