INCREASE IN SCHOOL FEES FOR 2019

Unfortunately, due to the rising costs of Education Outside the Classroom and swimming activities the 2019 activity fee is rising by \$10 to \$130 per year. We find that weekly or fortnightly automatic payments is the easiest way to keep on top of these fees so please contact Michelle in the office if you would like to set this up. <u>ACTIVITY FEE – COMPULSORY FEE - \$130 FOR THE YEAR</u>

The compulsory activity fee covers shows and trips (including the transport) that children attend each year. It also covers the mathematics and other IT programmes, classroom consumables and the swimming/aquatics programmes run throughout the year.

We have set budgets for these for 2019, so that parents can pay the money in one lump sum, on a term by term basis, or as a regular direct credit. **TOTAL \$130 per child, per year**
