### WAVE TV

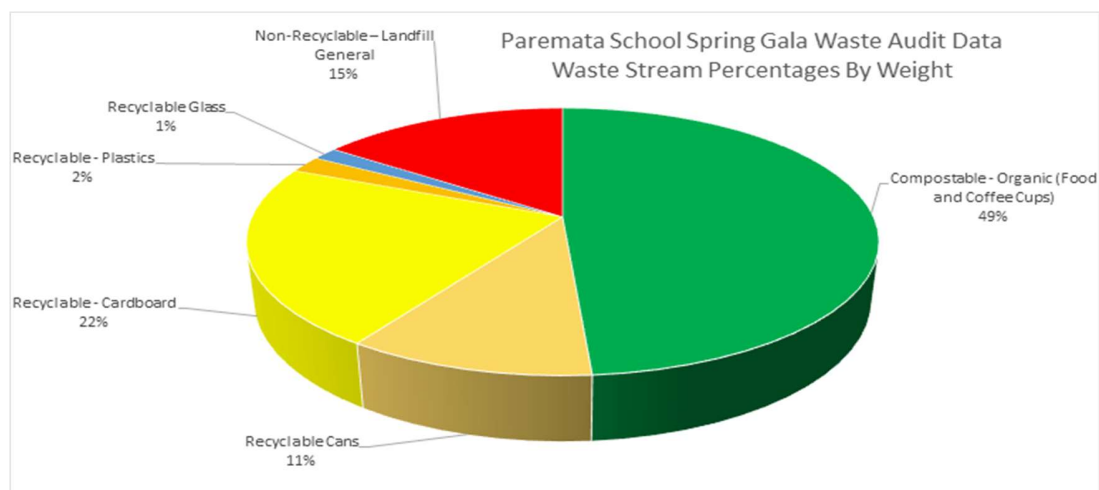

Our community can feel very proud of all the recycling and composting at our school gala this year. Have a look at the data below to see how well we did! Thanks again to all our volunteers who helped on the day to minimise our gala waste. Next year we have plans to do even better!
