COVID-19 Moving to Alert Level 1



Thank you for all your support following school processes under Alert Level 2. When we move to Level 1 contact tracing may no longer be mandatory but as a school we encourage you to use the QR bar codes that will be placed at the school gates tomorrow. At level 1 parents are very welcome to come into the school grounds before school and at 3pm. If you are collecting

your child during school hours, you will still need to sign in and out of the office. Signing your children into Before School Care is still a legal requirement.

Level 1 and School Attendance

Once Level 1 is in place all students are expected to attend school and can only be away if they are sick. If children are being kept at home due to COVID-19 concerns and are not unwell, the MOE will need to be informed.

Kapa Haka and Full School Assemblies

For Kapa Haka and school assemblies I will follow the recommendations from the MOE about large gatherings indoors and we may need to stay with the processes we have in place until the end of the term.
