Futsal:

Futsal is a fast pace game of indoor soccer played with 5 players on a basketball size court with no nets or walls. You're able to have unlimited substitutions, you can have as many players as you wish as long as 5 players take the court (this includes the goal keeper). No slide tackles and players must attempt to play the ball rather than the player. Get ready to showcase your superstar, soccer talent skills.

Rules:

1. Five players to take the court at any time (this includes the goal keeper)
2. Played with a size 4 low bounce ball.
3. The match is played with two Ten-minute halves.
4. Unlimited substitutions but an existing player must have completely left the court before the replacing player steps onto the court.
5. No player off sides or height limits.
6. Shin pads can be worn by players if you wish.
7. Players must attempt to play the ball rather than the player.
8. No slide tackles
9. Kick in from the side line when the ball is out of bounds (not a throw in).

Kiwi Volley:

I would like to take the opportunity to announce an exciting new sport. In partnership with Capital City Volley we are introducing Volleyball a great sport that children of all abilities can play. The games will be played 4 vs 4 players at Te Rauparaha Arena.

We'll start all grades with an elimination style of Volleyball, where teams catch and throw the ball over the net if the ball hits the ground a player is eliminated from the court. Play continues until one team has eliminated all the opponents from the opposition then they are awarded a point.

We want tamariki to be successful and enjoy the sport they play, we will provide support and coaching from the umpire and as the tamariki improve their skills we'll add new rules and included set and spikes where we see to ability.
