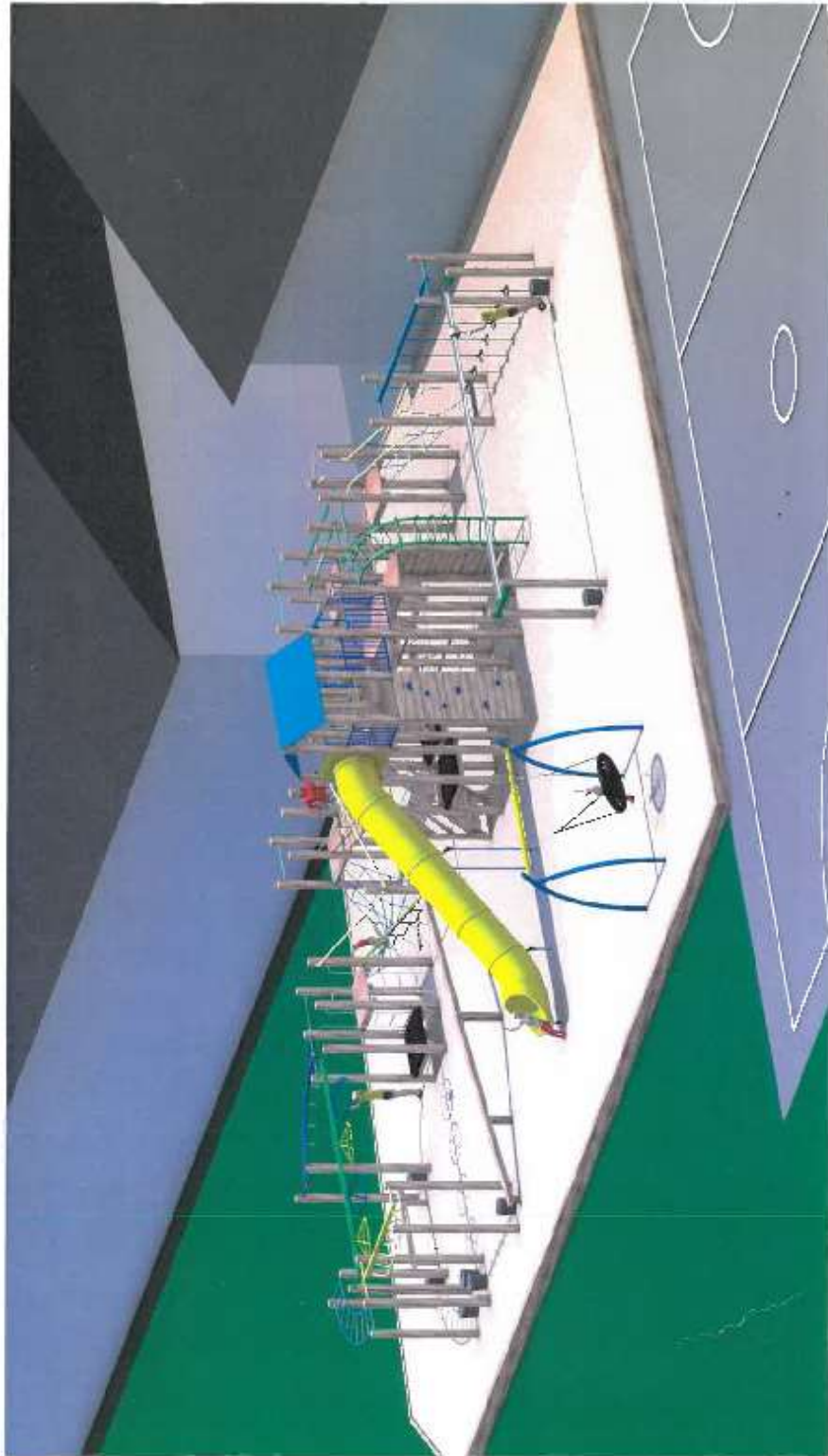


Paremata School Hall will be holding the voting services for the 2020 General Election on the following dates:
