Epro8 is an engineering challenge that teams from around Porirua partake in. Paremata entered two Y 7 & 8 teams. Each team included four participants that were challenged to build a theme from the items supplied in an Epro8 box. These included three sizes of aluminium bars, axles, wheels, cranks, cogs, joiners, rope, and nuts and bolts. This year our challenge was to build an animal for a zoo and there were criteria for the build, such as the build having to be at least one metre in size so ants would be massive and elephants would be tiny and having at least one crank mechanism. Our first team Eamonn, Lily C, Marcus and Alesana built a moa, and the second team Pōtiki, Felix, Ian, Aidan built a pterodactyl (yes it was classified as an animal). We didn't only have to build the animal but also had to write a one-page report on our animal as well as take a video of the team showcasing it. During the week we had to finish our report and build, both teams hastened to finish it. When it came to judging, team two came in third place! Team two will be entering the finals against the other top eight schools in the near future... By Ian Wen
