LIBRARY NEWS



Every year, in December, I do a stocktake of all the library books. This means that I scan all the books that the library has in it, to find out which books are missing. This helps keep the catalogue information up to date, as well as finding out if there are any books that I need to reorder. It also gives me an accurate number of books (stock) that there is in the library.

In order for this to be done, all the library books need to be returned by **Wednesday 2nd December** at the latest. I have to put all the library books in order (in their correct place) and then I need to check the shelves for any books still outstanding, in case they have slipped through.

SUMMER READING PROGRAMME

The school library will again be running the very successful Summer Reading Programme. An extra page giving background information on the <u>'Summer Reading Slide'</u> is attached to this newsletter. Children are required to have a signed permission form, a copy of which is also included with the newsletter, or a copy can be collected from the library, their classroom or downloaded from the library page on the school website.



This means the children get to choose **eight** books to read over the Summer Holiday. The library will be open extended hours before and after school for books to be issued. Children can also go in class time in arrangement with their teacher (as long as they have a signed form). Parents are most welcome to help their children select books.


