Monday 5th July to Friday 9th July

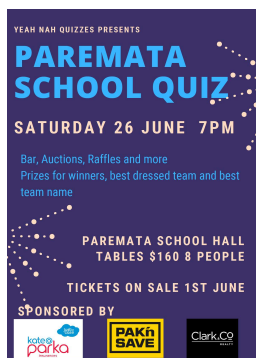
