Planning for a Covid outbreak at Paremata School

The BOT have discussed a plan on how we would keep everyone safe, if or when we get a Covid outbreak at our school. While the MOE have their own guidance for schools remaining open in a Covid outbreak, we will take measures that will keep our entire community safe.

Paremata School will follow the Covid-19 contacts Phase 2 plan – please see attached. This current plan may be revised and updated at any time.

If a child or staff member presents with Covid, the school would switch to online learning for the next ten days. This allows the school to evaluate any spread. We would expect those who were close contacts to be tested at day five. The online learning would be extended as needed, if other cases were reported.

Any confirmed cases would have to present a negative test before returning to school.

During the ten day online learning stage, information on Covid cases within the community will be used to evaluate whether the online learning period will be extended or the school returns to classroom learning.










Unfortunately, due to a low number of enrolments, we have had to cancel Kelly Sports at Paremata School for this term.
