A big thank you to Marilyn Hunt and the Gala Committee who raised \$28000 this year. It was a fantastic day and fabulous to see the community supporting our fundraising. The next step is to discuss and decide where to use this money in 2016. I would like to build a single garage in the school grounds for the PTA to store all of their equipment and donations for the gala. I will be taking this to the BOT meeting next week. Other ideas have been seating on the field, wet weather shelters, playground games and road markings for children to use and more planters around the school. Once the PTA have finalised their ideas I will write a budget plan to incorporate as many suggestions as possible to enhance the playground.
