Lucky Dip	Week3 8Aug-12Aug	Classroom teacher	Bubbles, small toys, colour pens, cars, stickers, mini balls, rubbers, keyrings. We will have separate dips for girls and boys, under 8's & over 8year olds. (un-opened fun items, no need to wrap)
Jar Surprise	Week4 15Aug-19Aug	Classroom teacher	Decorate the outside: hiding the contents.
