
Pupil Placements 2017

ENVIRONEWS

Porirua Harbour is 21km north of Wellington city. The harbour was first named Parirua which translates to "twin flowings of the tide".

There are two parts to the harbour. Onepoto flows from the Paremata Bridge south and ends at the shore of Porirua City. This inlet is popular with rowers, powerboats, small dinghies and personal water craft users.

The second arm is Pauatahanui Inlet and stretches eastwards from the Paremata Bridge past the suburb of Whitby and contains which has a world-class wetland reserve area, of the same name, at the end. This inlet is a popular spot for yachting, water skiing (the ski club is on the northern side) and boating.
