Dear Parents and Caregivers,

As you will be aware from last year Lily Cooke has been diagnosed with a rare autoimmune disorder which is not contagious to other children in any way. She is now progressing well towards full health after a Bone Marrow Transplant.

Developing an infection remains a concern for Lily, particularly stomach bugs with vomiting or diarrhea which will put her health at risk. It can be life threatening if Lily comes into contact with chicken pox or measles.

If you think your child may have measles or chicken pox can you please let the school know immediately so Lily can be removed from school until it is safe for her to return.

We thank you for helping us keep Lily safe throughout the winter terms by keeping children home until fully recovered from any colds, flu, stomach bugs, measles and chicken pox and we appreciated you telling us if you thought this may impact on Lily.
