Did you know that keas are native parrots and only found in New Zealand? They are large, strong, cheeky and intelligent birds who love to play tricks on people. Their diet is seeds, fruit, plants and bugs. Keas can have green wings and their body colour is a

yellowish colour maybe even brown.

Keas make a burrow deep underground under a beech tree roots. Sadly some of their eggs are eaten by stoats and possums (which are introduced). Keas can live up to 11 years which is amazing.
