ENVIRONEWS – RUMA KIWI – DID YOU KNOW THAT ...



Pāuatahanui Inlet is the only large estuary wetland left in the lower half of New Zealand's North Island. It is under threat from three things — too much sediment, pollution and eutrophication - that's a big word which means increasing concentration of plant nutrients which can be harmful to the Inlet.



A fourth problem may be from the local effects of climate change, which could include a rise in sea level, more rainfall and increase in the amount of storms. The Guardians of Pauatahanui Inlet are working hard to make look after the Inlet.
