How can I support my children to enjoy real-life projects...?

- tell them to have a go!
- providing them with the tools for learning.
- encourage their natural curiosity

How can I support my child to improve their ability to make choices in their learning? And be able to act on this...?

- find out what they're interested in.
- know what's going on...
- give them choices
- take part in decision-making
- encourage critical thinking like, "what would happen if you did ... or did ...?" "Which is preferable"
- Encourage my child to ask questions and wonder what would happen if ...?
- Empower her to follow through with choices and experimentation.
- Ask questions how; why; what would you do?
