CHANGES TO METLINK SCHOOL SERVICES FROM TERM 3 2018

From **Sunday 15 July 2018**, there are big changes to public transport in Wellington, which means from Term 3 2018 there will be changes for school students using Metlink buses and trains in Porirua and surrounding suburbs.

If your students use public transport to travel to and from school, they need to know about <u>changes to fares and tickets</u> for Metlink trains and buses from **Sunday 15 July 2018**, ahead of the start of Term 3.

Our new Metlink lemon and lime buses are on their way to Porirua, but not all at once. Please remind your students to check the route number and destination, rather than the colour of the bus, before they get on-board.

Changes to how students pay to get to and from school

If you use a Mana/Newlands card to pay for school bus travel

From **Sunday 15 July 2018**, Snapper will be the only card accepted on Metlink public and school buses in the Wellington region. So from the start of **Term 3 on 23 July 2018**, Snapper will replace all Mana/Newlands cards on Metlink school buses in Porirua.

We want to make this change as easy as possible for you, so we'll give you a new replacement Snapper card for free and if you want to pay by cash, you still can.

School term passes are being discontinued

From **Sunday 15 July 2018** all school students will receive a <u>50% discount</u> on the equivalent adult fare.

If you use school term passes on buses, these will continue to be accepted until the end of Term 2, Friday 6 July 2018.

From the start of **Term 3, Monday 23 July 2018**, school term passes will be discontinued and students using Metlink services will need to pay using a Snapper card with a Child Concession for Metlink buses, or use Metlink rail 10-Trip Tickets and Monthly Passes on trains.
