Teachers Strike Update

As you may be aware all schools in NZ will be closed due to the teachers strike on **Wednesday 29 May.** While Minister Hipkins keeps mentioning the pay deal as being very generous, the stalemate is around teacher release time during the school day to



keep up with the administrative workload which is done outside the school day and during the school holidays. What the government is not acknowledging is that currently a teacher at the very top of the teachers' pay scale who works 60 hours a week (which is quite common) is earning \$18.66 net per hour. Even with a 10% increase in salary over three years this will only increase the hourly rate to \$20.16 net per hour by 2022. For teachers just starting in their career they are currently earning \$13 net per hour on a 60-hour week which is \$4.70 under the minimum wage. This is why teachers are not choosing to go teaching or moving to careers where there is better money and less administrative workload outside an 8-5 pm work day.
