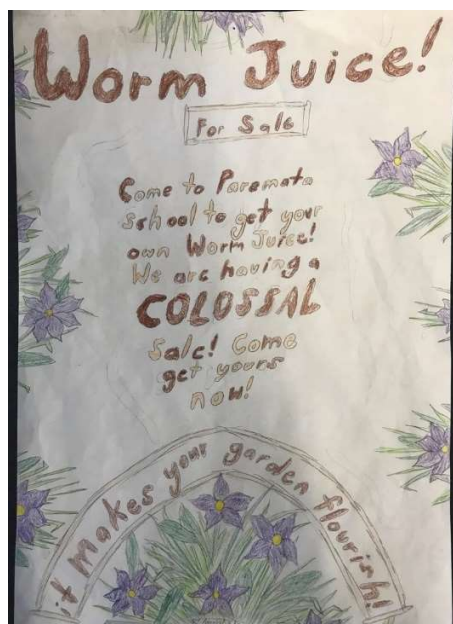
Centenary Badges
