Awesome effort to Lachlan G from Room 16 for being the pupil who sold the most raffle tickets – an amazing 59 books!

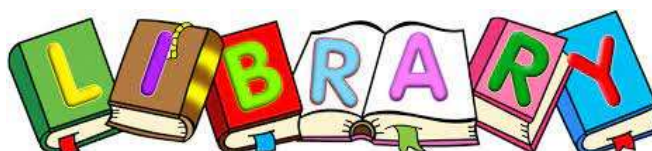
