classrooms. If you wish to take part, please register your interest and pick up a cake box from the office.



Just a friendly reminder that sunhats are compulsory in Term 4. We have school hast available for sale at the office for \$15.00.






Last chance to buy a ticket for a signed Warriors Jersey

Wednesday's 3.05pm – 4.05pm, starts Wednesday 18 October 2023 for 8 weeks.


