KORU Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc Rose 2022\* Produced for our overseas markets this wine has aromatics of passionfruit & raspberry, following through to the palate for a fruit driven wine. Try with seafood, Mediterranean cuisine, or as an aperitif with friends. Serve lightly chilled. SILENI STRAITS RESERVE Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc 2019\* An elegant wine with

flavours of lime, grapefruit, citrus, passionfruit, papaya & stonefruits with hints of lavender & dried herbs & a slightly drier finish. Delicious with fish, Asian cuisine or a platter of soft cheeses. Drink chilled.

SPINYBACK Nelson Pinot Gris 2022\* Nashi pear, white clover honey, lemon curd and floral aromas with the juicy fruit sweetness of pear, rock melon & nectarine. Try with seafood & Asian cuisine or drink as an aperitif with friends along with a platter of soft cheeses, dried fruits and Turkish Delight.

**OVERSTONE Hawke's Bay Merlot 2020\*** Labelled for our Asian markets aromas of plum, blackcurrant & dark berry with a hint of elegant spice notes, typical of Hawke's Bay Merlot. Dark berryfruit flavours with excellent depth & a delicious soft finish, perfect for drinking any time of the year.

**GREYROCK Hawke's Bay Syrah 2022\*** Dark in colour with luscious berry fruit flavours and a hint of black pepper and smokiness leading to a velvety smooth finish. Fantastic with hearty pastas, beef and NZ lamb or enjoy with a platter of aged cheddar.
