School Donation

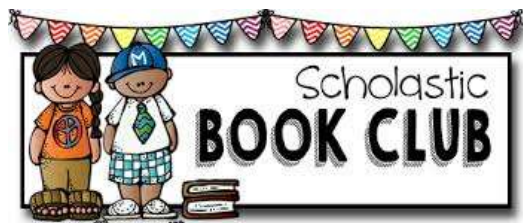
