This year's theme for Te Vaiaho o te Gagana Tokelau – Tokelau Language Week is **'Tokelau, tāofi mau tau aganuku, ko tō pale tēnā - Tokelau, holdfast to your culture, that is your crown.'**

According to UNESCO, the Tokelau language is classified as severely endangered. There are few opportunities to learn the language in the community or through formal education in Aotearoa New Zealand. However, Gagana Tokelau is now a NCEA-accredited subject.


ParentLink Fundraising for Term 4

If your child was absent earlier in the year when photos were taken and you would like a portrait done, please let Marie in the office know.




Team Photos are on Tuesday, 5th November before school from 8:00am in the library. All uniforms need to be worn and then handed back after the photos.
